Goal

Healthy Skin in Greater Wellington

Outcomes

Decreased incidence of people with skin infection

Decreased severity of skin infection

Decreased recurrent serious skin infection

Decreased disparities in burden of skin infection

Reduced spread of infections

More prevalent prevention including management of other skin conditions

Better access to care at the right levels

Increased understanding of how to prevent and manage skin infections in the community

Environment promotes healthy skin

Support from wider social sector to address health determinants. Including housing issues

Consistent messages on management of skin infections from and between health professionals

Data collection including evaluation

Workforce development

Engagement with preventive, primary, secondary and tertiary services and wider sector

Local activities linked through network



Focus resource to where the problem is greatest

Work with whanau with a focus on children and communities

Settings - educational, work, sport, cultural

Housing environment - pest control, linen, care of pets

Income - access to resources through Work & Income

Access to health care - community, primary, secondary, tertiary services
