## Measles alert – multiple Wellington locations of interest

#### Measles case

Te Whatu Ora National Public Health Service Wellington region has been alerted that a person with confirmed measles was staying in Wellington. The case's infectious period in Wellington is from **29 September to 3 October 2023**. Public health has identified locations the case visited in Wellington during this time.

#### Contacts of the case

Potential cases could develop early **prodromal** symptoms (high fever, cough, coryza, sore red eyes, myalgia) from **9 October to 13 October** (range 6 -21 October) and measles **rash onset** from **13 October to 17 October** (range from 6 to 24 October).

Locations visited by the case while in Wellington are on the next page and will also be listed on the Te Whatu Ora website.

#### Key actions for primary care at this time

- Review your waiting room protocol; ensure early triage and use of masks to avoid disease transmission to vulnerable patients
- Discuss suspected cases on suspicion with Public Health and contact the Microbiology registrar
  or SMO on-call to alert the laboratory of the need for urgent PCR testing. Discuss with
  Microbiology if unsure how to take samples safely
- Ensure you include relevant clinical details and the date of rash onset on the laboratory request form
- Do NOT send patients into Awanui Labs collection centres for measles testing as this puts others at risk
- Serology (IgM) is not useful for diagnosis of suspected measles
- Serology (IgG) testing of contacts can be helpful in some situations this will be guided by Public Health
- Measles is a notifiable condition. Notify suspected cases of measles to Public Health on 04 570 9002; this number is monitored 24/7
